As you might have noticed, this year we took a different approach to unpacking the conference theme. For the first time we hosted panel discussion, the idea behind this was to gain more insight into the topic from different experts. We received positive feedback from our delegates regarding panel discussions. One delegate from the University of Ghana said, “I used to think we are the only ones with challenges in our university but after the panel discussion I realized that we are all facing the same challenges”.

Additionally, we have introduced an incentive system related to the completion of the conference survey. The purpose behind this is to gather feedback from you, which will help us improve and better serve your needs.

4. Finance

The financial status of ITSIUG remains healthy, due to diligent financial management and the continuous growth in membership and attendance at the Annual Conference, which serves as our primary revenue stream. We have received the auditor’s report, which has been disseminated to everyone via the ITS User Group website. The auditors have thoroughly examined our Financial Statements for the period ending on December 31, 2023, and have expressed their satisfaction with our financial records. On behalf of the ITS User Group EXCO and the wider community, I extend our sincere appreciation to our treasurer, Mr. Bobby Bezuidenhout, for his exceptional service and invaluable contributions to ITSIUG. Bobby, your unwavering dedication and expert management of ITSI User Group finances are truly commendable and greatly appreciated.

5. Report back on SWT (Specialist Working Team)

EXCO had a meeting with Adapt IT in September 2023 to discuss the way forward for the SWT workshops. In that meeting, Adapt IT shared with us the concept of design thinking workshops. The idea behind the design thinking workshops is to meet with the users of the ITS system at the institutions, including students. Discussions in these workshops are related to challenges and frustrations being faced by the users. From these workshops also came innovative ideas, especially from the students. The outcome of these workshops is what Adapt IT will use to pave their roadmap and build the system according to the needs of the users.

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One of the questions we raised was, will design thinking workshops replace SWTs, and we were assured we that these workshops complement, rather than replace, SWTs, by offering a comprehensive roadmap for system development. Institutions are still welcome to submit SWT requests; the submissions will be evaluated by Adapt and see if they cannot be incorporated into the Design Thinking workshops and be discussed further.

There were two SWTs requests submitted last year.

5.1 ITS Integrator Asset and Vehicle Booking on iEnabler and Back Office.

Adapt IT has agreed to first have a discovery engagement with the respective institutions on 10 April 2024 9am – 10am and then plan the next steps accordingly with User Group Exco. The invitations for this meeting will be sent out early next week.

5.2 New generation application self-service.

This SWT included some of the previous submissions and detailed feedback was provided to the User Group representatives via email on 02 Nov 2023.

6. Conference 2025 Venue

2025 conference will be held at Emperors Palace in Gauteng province, South Africa. Further information will be provided in due course. EXCO will continue to explore more conference venues for the coming year.
